## 5 Introduction

- 6 Waste items requiring radiation surveillance can be any unwanted radioactive material, including
- 7 naturally occurring radioactive material, radioactively contaminated items, equipment containing
- 8 embedded radioactive sources and unwanted radiation producing devices. The lowa Department of
- 9 Health and Human Services (Iowa HHS), by agreement with the Nuclear Regulatory Agency (NRC),
- regulates the handling of radioactive waste in lowa.
- 11 The Radiation Safety Committee (RSC) is responsible for ensuring that radioactive materials and
- radiation producing devices are disposed of properly. The Department of Environmental Health and
- Safety (EH&S) manages the radioactive waste with guidance from the RSC. EH&S collects,
- manages, and arranges for the disposal of all radioactive waste generated at lowa State University.
